ENTRY GUIDELINE LETTER

Dear entrants and supporters of the 22nd Balaklava Eisteddfod,

If this is your first time entering we give you a warm welcome and trust that your experience with us will be positive, rewarding and enjoyable. If you have entered before we are delighted to have you back and thank you for your continued support.

The Rules & Conditions of Entry and the Syllabus have been reviewed and some changes made that need to be noted before entering the Balaklava Eisteddfod. In particular, **see page 7 of the Syllabus** for details. Some of the numbering and wording of Rules has been changed (Rules 6, 7 & 8).

NEW RULE in the 'ENTRIES' section of the Rules & Conditions of Entry as follows:

Rule 6 a) An entrant may enter ONLY TWO of the following voice (singing) SOLO SECTIONS:
Contemporary Vocal Solo, Musical Theatre Solo, Vocal Solo, Vocal Classical Solo and Vocal Non-classical Solo. (This does not affect entry into the Vocal Scholarship)

6 b) An entrant may enter ONCE ONLY in each of the following ENSEMBLE SECTIONS:
Contemporary Vocal Ensemble (2-4 voices), Musical Theatre Ensemble (2-4 voices) and Vocal Small Ensemble (2-4 voices)

Choral Workshop: Participants will need to forward a copy of the scores to Di Spence, BY MONDAY 18th JUNE 2018. These copies can be either posted to Di Spence at 19 Christopher St, Balaklava SA 5461 or emailed to spenbal@rbe.net.au.

Singing Sections: (Contemporary Vocal, Musical Theatre & Vocal Disciplines) - See note above re Rule 6 This is to help reduce the number of singing solos so that programming is made easier and the day doesn't run so late. If a section fills to capacity, entry to that section will close early. If a section closes early, notice will be made on our Facebook page and via email or phone. Accompanist name/s **must** appear on your entry forms as it is crucial information for programming. We encourage you to get your Entry Forms WITH payment in early to secure your chosen sections.

Speech & Drama:

We have a new venue this year at the Balaklava High School in the newly built Performing Arts Centre. Please note the new time limit for SOLO drama is now only 5 minutes maximum.

Group drama remains at 8 minutes maximum time limit. Also new this year is the addition of Group Drama for 5-9 performers. We ask that groups entering this section have a group name to put on the entry form and details of members to be put on page 3 of the Saturday entry form.
