SATURDAY PROGRAMME

CONTEMPORARY VOCAL (Amplified Voice) DISCIPLINE

- Solo & Ensemble (2-4 voices) sections

MUSICAL THEATRE DISCIPLINE

- Solo & Ensemble (2-4 voices) sections

VOCAL DISCIPLINE

- Solo (Classical & Popular), Duet & Trio sections, Vocal Scholarship for age **15-20 yrs** entered in Vocal Classical Solo
